

OUT OF BOUNDS POLICY 2023-24

Policy Aims:

Safeguarding is the most important aspect of life at The Hammond. This policy has been created to help guide pupils and students into making good choices and understanding the areas of main site and the areas at the boarding houses that are out of bounds.

The rationale behind making these areas out of bounds is to ensure the safety of all. Any violation of these rules will be dealt with as per our Behaviour Management Policy: unintentional transgressions will be deemed minor issues, intentional and/or repeated transgressions will be deemed serious issues. The Hammond will not take responsibility for any incidents that occur if a pupil or student has violated this policy.

Unless under the direct and present supervision of a member of staff, the following areas are out of bounds:

- Any public and private space beyond the perimeter of the main school site at Hoole Bank
- All maintenance and cleaning rooms, facilities, storage spaces at the main school site and in boarding houses.
- Staff rooms (including staff accommodation and kitchen areas)
- Car parks (unless walking through to reach an approved destination)
- Fire escapes and other emergency exits (unless the fire alarm has sounded)
- Roofs and sides of all Hammond buildings
- Lifts
- Music practice rooms (unless acting with the permission of a member of the Music Department)
- Toilets and changing rooms to which you have not been assigned
- Staff offices
- The loading bay in the Performing Arts Centre
- The kitchens and the delivery area to the kitchens at main site
